The West Norwich Partnership

The West Norwich Partnership is a community led, independent registered charity, formed in 1995 to facilitate an improvement in the quality of life and services for those living and working in the Earlham, Larkman, Marlpit and Bowthorpe areas of West Norwich. West Norwich Partnership (or WNP, as it is often known), is led by a Board of Voluntary Trustees appointed by the community, and is managed by a committee comprising multi-agency and voluntary community representatives who work or live in the communities served. Members include representatives of the two local authorities, Norwich City Council and Norfolk County Council, and Norfolk Police.



West Norwich Partnership has a child protection policy, which is reviewed annually and all information held about individuals will not be passed on to any other organisation

Funding

West Norwich Partnership receives funding from Norfolk County Council, Children in Need and the Kerrison Trust. Without the generous contributions from these bodies, we would be unable to provide this year's Sorted trips.

Transport

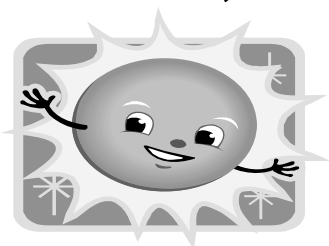

These buses are also fitted with three way seatbelts for added security. Transport for 10-16s activities may also be provided by West Norwich Community Transport and Norfolk County Council.

Code of Conduct for all activities

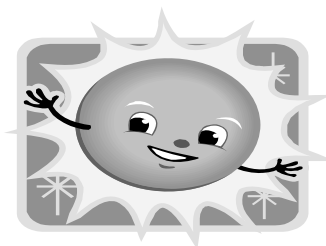
